



## **INFORMATION SHEET: NEW THIRD ARMY HEADQUARTERS INFRASTRUCTURE AT SHAW**

### **Headquarters Building**

- 321K SFT 2 story Building
- March 2011 Construction Complete - Building Certification/accreditation within 90 days

### **Headquarters and Headquarters Company/Tactical Equipment Maintenance Facility (TEMF)**

- 25K SFT Building – 25K SF, Most of the space is configured for bulk ARCENT section storage
- Tactical Equipment Maintenance Facility (TEMF): Building Total (Gross) 14,920 SF
- March, 2011 Construction Complete and Ready for Occupancy

### **Headquarters Building**

- 2-story building
- The following facilities are included in the main headquarters building:
  - Operations, administrative work areas for over 1470 personnel and up to 300 pax auditorium
  - A fully functional multimedia COIC
  - Conference/briefing area, senior leadership conference room, a Sensitive Compartmented Information Facility (SCIF), Network Operations center, simulations center, common use video teleconference (VTC) facility, Communications Security (COMSEC) vault, mail room, loading dock, break rooms, and office equipment rooms
  - A 1,450 square foot space for a food service area

### **Headquarters, Headquarters Company (HHC) Building**

- 1-story building
- Designed to accommodate one company headquarters and Third Army's bulk storage currently staged in a building at Fort Gillem
- Areas are sized for a complete redeployment of Third Army from the CENTCOM AOR resulting in a much larger Arms Vault, NBC Storage, Communications Storage, Supply, Maintenance Shops, and General Storage

### **Tactical Equipment Maintenance Facility (TEMF)**

- 6-bay facility totaling 14,980 square feet
- A Tactical Equipment Maintenance Facility (TEMF) is to be included in this project
- Includes parking for 100% of the MTOE assigned vehicles, and 200 8' X 20" deployment storage containers.

- Contract: \$92 Million (Includes Headquarters, HHC and TEMF)

**\*NOTE\*** Gymnasium, Barracks, Child Development Center expansion and transient lodging associated with the move are Air Force funded and costs have not been released at this time
