

### **Amnesty Box**

- Dispose of any prohibited/restricted items in Amnesty Box.
- Last and final chance for Amnesty
- After leaving the Amnesty Box area you can, and will, be prosecuted under the UCMJ

### **Ammunitions**

- Any live ammunition
- Shell casings
- Projectiles
- Explosives
- Mines
- Rockets
- Grenades
- Flares
- Smoke grenades
- Pieces of these items are strictly prohibited.

### **Pornography**

- Pornography which reveals any genitalia
- Possession of Pornography is a Direct Violation of GO-1B
- Personnel in possession of Pornography after the Amnesty time will receive disciplinary action

### **Weapons**

- Switchblade knives, handcuff's and brass knuckles are prohibited
  - Government issued spring loaded knives are authorized (with proper documentation)
- Club type hand weapons are prohibited
  - Government issue batons and handcuffs are authorized (with proper documentation)
- Hatchets, machetes, swords are authorized in checked bags (must be sheathed)

### **Lighters**

- No butane or gas lighter fluid
- Matches, except for strike anywhere matches, are allowed. (4 packs)
- Disposable lighters and butane lighters are prohibited
- Zippos lighters are restricted

### **Agricultural Items**

- Soil, dirt and shells are prohibited
- Sand that is in a sealed container and marked as bleached is authorized
- Commercially processed marble and rocks are authorized

- Any fried, dried or canned meats and fresh fruits or vegetables are prohibited
- Commercially dried fruits and vegetables are ok

### **Drugs**

- Any controlled substance that is illegal in the United States is prohibited
  - Prescriptions must have your name on the bottle or baggy.
  - All pills must be in the original container.
  - Pills cannot be mixed together with other pills.
- All over the counter and dietary substances must be in the original containers.

### **Alcohol and Tobacco**

- Alcohol is prohibited
- Atropine injectors must be in a check bag
- “Hookah Pipes” are authorized (free of residue)
- Tobacco products are limited to 100 legal cigars and 200 cigarettes
- Cuban cigars, cigarettes and Indian “Beadie” cigarettes are prohibited

### **Prohibited Items**

- Animals, insects and plants in whole or part, alive or dead are prohibited.
- Only insects preserved are allowed
- No human bones, teeth or body parts
- License plates from Kuwait or Iraq
- Weapons Replica's

### **Restricted Items**

- Trademark items such as fake Rolex watches or Oakley sun glasses are restricted on one
- Bootleg CD's or DVD's are restricted to one per title

### **CARRY-ON BAGGAGE**

- Disposable Razors
- Tools 7 inches or less may go into a carry on bag
  - Anything greater than 7 inches must go into a check bag.
- Scissors 4 inches or less may go into a carry bag
- Any scissors larger than 4 inches must go into a check bag.
- Cigar cutters
- cork screws

- cuticle cutters
- eyelash curlers
- sewing needles
- clippers, nail files
- toy weapons (unrealistic)
- umbrellas
- tweezers
- canes
- camcorders camera equipment
- mobile phones
- laptop computers
- pagers
- PDA's
- treated wood

### **Classified Material**

- Personnel carrying classified material must have ALL of these items:
  - proper identification
  - a courier card
  - courier orders
  - inventory of classified materials
  - properly packaged

### **Personal War Souvenirs**

- Helmets and head coverings
- Bayonets

- Uniforms and uniform items such as insignia and patches
- Canteens
- Compasses
- Rucksacks
- Load bearing equipment
- Flags
- Military training manuals (unclass)
- Books, and pamphlets
- Posters
- Placards
- Pouches

### **For R & R Flights**

- Travelers may now carry through security checkpoints travel-size toiletries (3 ounces or less) that fit comfortably in ONE, QUART-SIZE, clear plastic, zip-top bag.
